## Important Tax Information

Under the *Katrina Emergency Tax Relief Act of 2005* certain deductibility restrictions on **cash contributions** (or cash equivalents such as checks and credit cards) to qualified 501(c)(3) organizations have been waived for contributions made between **August 28 and December 31, 2005**. For individuals, cash contributions made during this period are exempt from the 50 percent income limitation and the phase-out of itemized deductions. *As always, you are encouraged to seek your own tax advice and counsel prior to making any decisions regarding charitable contributions.*

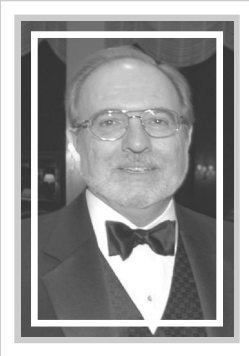

### A Letter From Our Executive Director

Dear Good Samaritans,

The year has flown by and thanks to your abounding charitable giving, I am happy to report that unrestricted contributions have increased over 10% compared to 2004 and that 2005 is shaping up to be one of our most successful years to date.

Speaking of local area generosity, on September 14, we held the inaugural Excellence in Nursing Awards (*see front page*). The luncheon (chaired by **Beth Wolff** and **Ken Wine**) was judged an overwhelming success by everyone involved. ## Good Samaritan Foundation's Annual Golf Tournament - 40th Anniversary

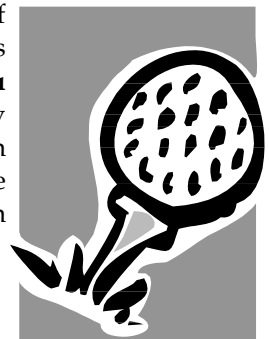

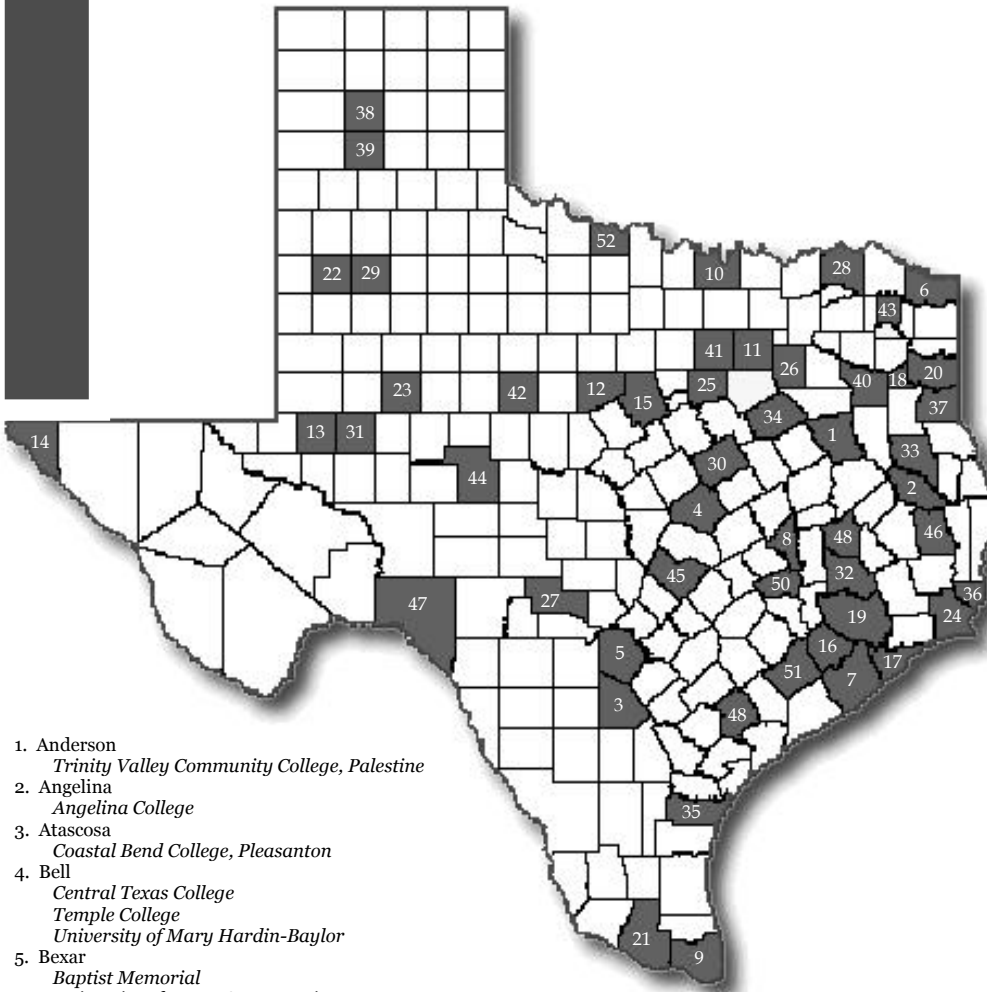


The tournament offers both morning and afternoon rounds, and with its popularity growing over the last few years, it has been practically a sell-out.

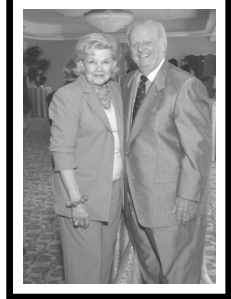
